

Dr. Fatma ERKÖK, Assoc. Prof.

Fatma Erkök is an Associate Professor at ITU Faculty of Architecture, where she received her B.Sc, M.Sc. and PhD degrees. Her PhD thesis was entitled “Objective and subjective evaluation of Istanbul in the context of its coastal city identity and urban components”. She has been a visiting scholar at IUAV (Venice School of Architecture) in 1997; and at TUdelft Faculty of Architecture in 2007-2008, with research grants received from the Italian government and the Scientific and Technological research council for Turkey (TÜBİTAK). She was involved in a number of international projects, summer schools and workshops. Her research focuses on issues like water-city relations, transformations in coastal cities, body-space relations, body and movement in architecture, interactive architecture. Her teaching is at undergraduate and graduate levels at ITU Faculty of Architecture. She is in the Program Executive Board of the Architectural Design Graduate Programme at ITU since 2012.
